

Playgroup Facilitator

The Women's Centre is seeking a Playgroup Facilitator for our playgroup for families with children from birth to school age. This is a unique opportunity to be creative and support families and children who do not always access other opportunities. This playgroup encourages women from all diverse groups to attend with their children.

Duties will include planning play based learning activities for children in consultation with participating families to ensure a high degree of parental involvement ensuring children's experiences are enriching and culturally sensitive. Setting up and facilitating the playgroup ensuring active participation from their caregivers. Record keeping of participants ensuring to maintain confidentiality.

Early Childhood Education/Child Care qualifications and work experience in the early Childhood sector and a current Working with Children Blue Card are essential.

Our playgroup is 4 hours of work per week. The playgroup runs during the school term only but the day could be flexible. There is also an opportunity for a second group to run each week taking the role to 8 hours per week.

Employment conditions are in accordance with the SCHCADS Award 2010 (relative to qualifications and experience). It is a genuine occupational requirement of this position that it be filled by a woman as permitted by, and arguable under Sections 25, 104 and 105 of The Anti-Discrimination Act 1991. First Nations and Culturally and Linguistically Diverse women are encouraged to apply.

The Women's Centre, provides counselling and group therapy and group activities, support, information and referral, for women experiencing emotional and psychological distress and trauma.
